The country's security – a fundamental pillar of its existence – has not only been shaken by the Israeli war with Hamas in the Gaza Strip but also by the unstable situation along its northern border with Lebanon and the recent unprecedented attack by Iran. This event convenes international experts for an in-depth discussion of the security implications of current developments for Israel, the wider region, and the global security landscape. It marks the conclusion of the fifth Sylke Tempel Fellowship cohort, which explored issues related to "Values in Security Policy".
