### In hopeful anticipation of a complete hostage deal & a lasting ceasefire: Join a Learning Trip to Israel on Community Resilience

March 24-30, 2025

The German-Israeli Future Forum invites professionals working in fields related to resilience and trauma to apply for a learning trip to Israel, taking place March 24-30, 2025, as part of our G17 for Resilience networking program. This second learning trip in the program will explore the remarkable resilience efforts of civil society activists and organizations across diverse and mixed communities.

The journey offers a unique opportunity to engage with grassroots organizations and community leaders and learn about various models and methods for building community resilience. It provides an authentic, community-driven perspective that focuses on real-life experiences rather than political agendas. The program will cover all major costs for participants.

#### Who are we looking for

We are seeking a small number of professionals from Germany to join this carefully curated group. The program is designed for individuals who work in fields related to resilience and trauma (e.g. NGOs, therapy, social work) and are comfortable participating in a program conducted in English (knowing that the focus is on learning and communication, not on fluency).

Preference will be given to applicants who:

- Work in NGOs
- Have no prior professional or personal affiliation with Israel
- Are under 45 (due to the target group outlined in our foundation's statutes)
