The German-Israeli Future Forum is inviting professionals working in the fields of trauma and resilience to apply for a unique learning trip to Israel, taking place November 11-17, 2024, as part of our **G17 for Resilience** networking program. The trip will explore the remarkable resilience efforts of civil society activists and organizations across diverse communities.

This journey offers a unique opportunity to engage with grassroots organizations and community leaders and learn about various models and methods for building community resilience. It provides an authentic, community-driven perspective that focuses on real-life experiences rather than political agendas. The program will cover all major costs for participants.

Who are we looking for

We are seeking a small number of professionals from Germany to join this carefully curated group. The program is designed for individuals who:

- Work in fields related to trauma and resilience (e.g., NGOs, therapy, social work)
- Are comfortable participating in a program conducted in English (knowing that the focus is on learning and communication, not on fluency)
- Are under 45 years old (due to our target group outlined in our foundation's statutes)

Preference will be given to those **without** prior professional and/or personal affiliation with Israel, as our network seeks to bring new actors into German-Israeli collaboration.
